As a discipline, American studies covers a wide range of research themes and approaches to thinking about issues relevant for America. This workshop will mirror the thematic and methodological openness of American studies and feature discussions of a wide range of issues pertaining to contemporary American studies, from its disciplinary basis to concrete issues of the American experience.
